Christmas Gift Giving

Last year, several of our churches took on a challenge to consider diverting some of their Christmas gift giving toward mission projects. There is an organization called Advent Conspiracy that challenges Christians to remember the real reason for Christmas. On their home page it says: “The story of Christ's birth is a story of promise, hope, and a revolutionary love. So, what happened? What was once a time to celebrate the birth of a Savior has somehow turned into a season of stress, traffic jams, and shopping lists. And when it's all over, many of us are left with presents to return, looming debt that will take months to pay off, and this empty feeling of missed purpose. Is this what we really want out of Christmas? What if Christmas became a world-changing event again? Welcome to Advent Conspiracy.”

If you and/or your church would like to participate in special mission giving this Christmas, here is a list of projects that need support:

Pakistan

\$50 for one month - provides rent and utilities for church meeting space, printing of literature
10 units of \$50 each are needed each month to provide assistance to the 10 churches that have been accepted into membership in the Church of God General Conference.
Bibles in Urdu—\$5.00 each—200 needed

Peru

\$20 needed per month to provide transportation for those traveling by bus to church groups that are located outside of Lima.

Africa

Funds needed for construction of church buildings in Malawi and Mozambique – 6 church buildings needed immediately. The people make the bricks and provide the labor. LHI provides the cement and tin for the roof.

Cement - \$20 per bag – 35 bags needed for each church building
Tin for roof - \$20 per sheet – 60 pieces needed for each church building
Bibles in Chichewa - \$7.00 each – 200 needed
Reading glasses - \$1 per pair – 100 needed
Food for orphans - \$20 per week to feed 100 children
500 orphans need to be fed so we need 5 gifts of \$20 per week to feed all 500 children.

Haiti

Funds are needed to reconstruct school and church buildings destroyed by the earthquake in January 2010. A team went last February and completed one building and plans are being made for another team to go in February or March to build a second building.

- Concrete for floor - \$70 per yard – 80 yards needed
- Cement blocks – \$1.50 each – 2,000 needed
- Sheet of roofing material - \$30 each – 50 needed
- Conduit - \$5.00 for 10 feet - 30 sections needed
- Other electrical supplies - \$8.00 each unit - 20 units needed
