We support ten churches that believe in the One True God in Pakistan. We help seven of these churches rent a space to hold services. For \$38, one church can rent one room for a month.


BIBLES \$10

BIBLES \$10


Allow Africans to dig deeper into their faith by giving a Bible in their own language. Last year, 370 Bibles were gifted to Malawi, Mozambique and Kenya. In fact, the Africa team bought all of the Bibles the Malawi Bible Society had! One Bible costs \$10.

LAPTOP \$10

Give a laptop as a ministry tool in Uganda. One laptop costs \$170.

BIKES \$10

Bikes give pastors the opportunity to travel to meet with their congregations and other pastors in the region. Bikes are needed in Kenya, Malawi, Uganda and Mozambique. One bike costs \$100.



BUILD A CHURCH \$50

Build a church in Africa for \$2,000-\$3,000. Last year, we built 8 new churches!

TIN \$8

Help congregations in Kimini and Chebosi, Kenya build tin meeting structures on their property. 1 piece of tin costs \$8. 250 pieces of tin are needed to complete these projects.

RENT \$15

Rent a church meeting space for three churches in Kenya. One month of rent costs between \$25 - \$50.

MATRESSES \$30

Give the gift of education! 25 mattresses for the Kenya Headquarters building are needed for pastors and students while taking Bible classes or attending conferences. 1 mattress costs \$30

Ten churches in Uganda need chairs for church members to sit on during services. Give a chair for \$6.

We support 24 churches in Haiti. Pastor Lesly Bertrand meets with ministers from these churches at a Bible Training Center for Bible studies and leadership training.



What is a Sower?

A Sower is a person, family, small group or church who pledge to sow seeds of love, faith and hope in a specific mission field monthly.

Why be a Sower?

LHI strives to equip ministries worldwide so that we can bring as many people into God's kingdom as possible. In 2019, LHI plans to give over \$80,000 to equip churches. While emergency needs and opportunities arise, much of our support is provided on a monthly, scheduled basis.

In HAITI, each month we give \$1,300 to support a Bible training center, 24 orphans, two mountain schools and disaster relief.

In RUSSIA, each month we give a varied amount of money to support the distribution of Bibles, Pastor Maksim's living and ministry expenses, 'big brother' orphan care and the publication of a Biblical newsletter.

In PAKISTAN, each month we give \$681 to support rent for 7 church meeting spaces and the distribution of Bibles.

In A F R I C A, each month we give a varied amount of money to support projects such as orphan care, emergency medical needs, distribution of Bibles, famine relief, building of new churches and Linda Limbe's living and ministry expenses.

A Sower will select one region to support (Haiti, Russia, Pakistan, Africa or All-Countries) and any monthly donation amount.
